- There will be **Breakfast after the 8am service** on 30th August as it is the 5th Sunday in the month. Please let David Biesley know if you intend to be there.
- **Chairs.** We have wanted for some time to replace the chairs we use in the Church Room as they are battered and inconvenient. We've been very fortunate in securing a grant from the Town Council to support the purchase of 84 folding steel-framed plastic-seated chairs which can be stored on moveable trolleys, and this will not only give us chairs that are easier and safer to store and move around, but will also free up storage space. The Council has confirmed that the Rural Life Museum at Tilford will gladly accept our old chairs and will arrange removal! It just remains to work out practicalities but the change should happen in the next few weeks.
- The Rector would like to offer a **mini-pilgrimage to the Holy Well at Dunsfold** on Saturday August 29th. We would meet at the Green in Dunsfold at 12noon and follow a short route via the footpaths to the well and back and then depending on weather have a picnic at the Green (the village shop sells a range of rolls and drinks). Do let James know if this is of interest.
- **Woodwork Painting.** Chris Sollars writes: 'The external woodwork of the Church Room has not been refurbished for a long time and our Quinquennial Inspection has recommended that it should be done soon. As it is a single storey building it would be possible to do this ourselves if we can put together a small team of willing people to help. The job could be done in stages, person power and weather permitting! Please contact the office if you would be willing to help with this.'
