### **General Election Voting**

As well as the Hustings mentioned in the Noticeboard section, do be aware that the deadline to register to vote in the election is midnight on Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup>. Check online at [www.gov.uk/register-to-vote](http://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote) or call Waverley Borough Council on 01483 523116. You'll also need photo ID to vote on July 4<sup>th</sup>. If you don't have the right ID you can apply for a Voter Authority Certificate but must do so by 5pm on June 26<sup>th</sup>. The online address to apply is <https://www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate> but again you can call Waverley BC.
