- **Helpful Habits – A 6-week course of prayer.** Would you like to deepen your prayer life, but aren't quite sure how? Would you like to pray more, but wonder where you will find the time or discipline to do so? *Helpful Habits* might be for you. This 6-week course aims to explore and deepen how we meet God in prayer. The sessions are about an hour in length, and they cover various aspects of prayer: practical ones like breathing and posture, and spiritual ones like using scripture and images in prayer. After the introduction, all sessions follow a pattern of starting with an explanation of the theme, then following this with trying things out and reflecting how this has helped our prayer (or not). It is a practical course seeking to help us go deeper in our time with God. It can run in the daytime or evening, depending on demand.
