**Services in August.** Please note that our services will be a bit different in August to accommodate the Churches Together Staycation service, which is on the 14<sup>th</sup> this year:

**Saturday August 6<sup>th</sup>** is the Feast of the Transfiguration. There will be an extra celebration of the Eucharist at 10am that day.

On **Sunday August 7<sup>th</sup>** there will be a Eucharist at 10am, rather than Sunday Space. The evening service at 6.30pm will be a quiet Evensong.

On **Sunday August 14<sup>th</sup>** anyone who can is warmly invited to join the Staycation service at the Bandstand at 10.30am. There will be celebrations of the Eucharist here at St John's at 8am and 6.30pm.

## NOTICEBOARD—DATES & INFORMATION

- **Broadwater Lodge.** We've been invited to resume the monthly communion services we used to hold at Broadwater Lodge before the pandemic. It would be good to do so. Laurie-Jean Davies was an ideal assistant but as she now finds it hard to get out I'd like to have someone else to help. It would involve assisting with communion and saying hello to the residents. We'd need to take a Lateral Flow Test before visiting. Do speak to me if you might be able to help. - James
- **Refugee support.** A neighbour of the Prestons, Philip Gardner, is supporting a colleague from the Royal Surrey Hospital who has taken extended leave to work in a support centre for Ukrainian refugees in Poland. He intends to take a vanful of supplies, including clothing for women and children, toiletries and sanitary products, to the centre at the end of July but will head off as soon as the van is full! If you can offer anything to this effort Patrick will be very glad to collect supplies. He can be contacted on 07929637320.  
Please also pray for households in our congregation, and the community more generally, who are hosting refugees at the moment.
- **Breakfast.** July has 5 Sundays so there will be breakfast after the 8am service on Sunday 31<sup>st</sup>. Alan and Barbara Hammond have kindly agreed to provide the Danish pastries, and four-legged members of the congregation will also be catered for. It would be helpful if David Biesley could have an idea of numbers so he can place a food order in the week beginning the 18<sup>th</sup>, so please let him know if you'd like to attend.
- Our friend **Yvonne Budd's funeral service** will be at the Crematorium on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> August at 1.30pm.
- A couple of weeks ago Geoff and James were invited to visit the new **Community Store** now based at Broadwater Cricket Club. They have a very impressive operation and are performing a vital service as many people find it harder to manage. They always welcome donations (you can find out what they need most on the Town Council website) and are open between 10am and 12.30pm, Monday to Friday. There's also a collection point at the Co-Op which supports the Food Bank at Ockford Ridge too.
