- **Fire Procedures.** At some point in the near future we will carry out a practice fire drill at the main Sunday service, to check our readiness in the event of this very unlikely possibility! Sidespeople and others will also need some training in fire safety procedures. We were going to do this just before the pandemic began and it's time to start it again.
- **Refugee support.** A neighbour of the Prestons, Patrick Gardner, is supporting a colleague from the Royal Surrey Hospital who has taken extended leave to work in a support centre for Ukrainian refugees in Poland. He intends to take a vanful of supplies, including clothing for women and children, toiletries and sanitary products, to the centre at the end of July but will head off as soon as the van is full! If you can offer anything to this effort Patrick will be very glad to collect supplies. He can be contacted on 07929637320.
- **Breakfast.** July has 5 Sundays so there will be breakfast after the 8am service on Sunday 31st. Alan and Barbara Hammond have kindly agreed to provide the Danish pastries, and four-legged members of the congregation will also be catered for. It would be helpful if David Biesley could have an idea of numbers so he can place a food order in the week beginning the 18th, so please let him know if you'd like to attend.
- **St Columba's House in Woking** is running a retreat for anyone exploring a sense of vocation on 14-16 October; and a short course of 3 sessions on 14th, 21st and 28th July on 'Compassion for Ourselves and Others', focussing on mental health.
